

Scholarship Program For High School Students



Guidelines for evaluation committee to select best candidates

The Nepali Ghar scholarship selection process documentation is designed to provide guideline to the Selection committee and to give students an opportunity to showcase their excellence in leadership and participating in the competition.

Award Amounts

Nepali Ghar will provide scholarships of \$2,000 annually, splitting between two eligible students. Each Student will receive \$ 1,000 in total to support first year of their college. Student will receive one \$ 500 check for the first semester and second check of \$ 500 for second semester within their first year of college.

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for a new scholarship, all students must meet the following eligibility criteria

- Recently graduated from any of the High School within Colorado State.
- Must be planning to enroll in college or university in the fall semester as a full time.
- Demonstrated Volunteer Commitment to the Community.
- Have met a minimum cumulative grade of 75% or (3.0 GPA equivalent)
- Received written acceptance from your selected college(s) – copy of the acceptance must be included in the application.
- Completed and submitted application materials by the post marked deadline date.

Selection Process:

The Selection Committee reviews all applications to determine the best overall applicants. Two highest-rated students are selected as scholarship recipients.

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic record, leadership ability, participation in school activities, and community service.

Evaluation Process:

- GPA – 50%
- Volunteer Involvement in Nepali Community Events / Activities – 25 %
- Essay – 25%

Distribution of Scholarships:

Both winning candidate will be announced at the Scholarship Distribution Event organized by Nepali Ghar during 1st week of August. Scholarship funds are sent to the financial aid office at their recipient's college or university. Checks are issue twice yearly – first and second semester and made payable to the award recipient and the College.
